- the overall strategic objectives and direction of the organization define in Diehl Metering Vision and Mission;
- guiding principles where Employee is one of critical cornerstone;
- clear responsibilities and authorities assignment and communication at all levels within the organization and maintained as documented information
- open and clear communication;
- continual performance evaluation and monitoring of the management system to improve OH&S² performance by internal audits, process review and management review
- process for identifying hazards, controlling risks and taking advantage of opportunities;
- consultation, involving and participation of all employees
- compliance with its legal requirements and other requirements

Following these internal processes, which present our minimum standard for Occupational health and safety management system, Diehl Metering demonstrate conformity with the requirement of ISO 45001:2018¹ by making a self-determination and self-declaration according to point 0.5 ISO 45001:2018¹ standard.
