CHARACTERISTICS

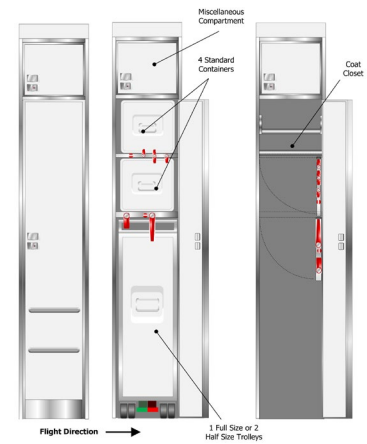
Modern aircraft cabins need to be able to support the increasing flexibility in the use of an aircraft for routes from short to long haul and the corresponding alteration of required catering capacity. Aside from various distances, the different route destinations necessitate versatile requirements. The Stowalley is a versatile monument supporting such flexibility with its easy conversion from a dry galley/shelf storage unit to a coat closet.

BENEFITS

- Flexible use of monuments without tools or loose parts, and no need for re-certification
- Easy updates of Trim & Finish by replacing of decor panels
- Quick adaption to altered needs due to route or season change: coat closet in winter, catering (dry galley) or shelf stowage in summer
- Trolley garage, coat closet, or shelf stowage? Just a second away!

FEATURES

- Stowage/Dry Galley Unit interior compartments easily switched around (for change of use)
- So in summer it stores trolleys, standard containers and drawers; in the winter (the shelves are folded and) it becomes a coat closet
- Trim & Finish easily changed with new decor panels, forward and aft
- No loose parts in the easy and quick switch from dry galley to coat closet
